Free Fresno State - Parent University Virtual Courses for All Turlock Residents!

The City recently partnered with Fresno State - Parent University to offer no-cost virtual courses to all Turlock residents (of all ages). Upon completion of each 4 week course, participants will receive a certificate from Fresno State University. There were 103 registrations for the first session that started in October 2024, 30 registrations in November 2024, and 130 registered for February 2025.

Business Workshops

Supporting start-ups and entrepreneurs is a strategic investment within economic development. Innovation can drive new ideas, technologies, and create the "Spark" of a new business to open up, resulting in job creation, and adding more value to the local economy. One of the ways that the City of Turlock supports start-ups and entrepreneurs is by providing no-cost business workshops and implement business development programs. Business workshops take place within the City of Turlock monthly, and have different topics and strategies presented by different guest speakers.



City of Turlock Small Business Development & Assistance Program

The City of Turlock's newly launched Small Business Development and Assistance Program provides strategic consulting and business development strategies to elevate Turlock small businesses. The businesses eligible to participate must be Turlock businesses that have a business license with the City of Turlock, operate out of a commercial location in Turlock, have no more than 50 employees, and not be part of a franchise or corporate chain.

The business development program is limited to 100 businesses and will provide up to \$3,500 (while funds last) for online business ads through Google Search Ads and Meta (Facebook/Instagram) Ads.

On 1/24/2025 the City of Turlock leadership team was alerted that Foster Farms will be laying off 519 employees by May 2025.

The announcement advised that 519 Foster Farms employees would be let go in May 2025, and the following Foster Farms Facilities located in Turlock will be closing:

- The fresh turkey operations located at 500 F. Street, Turlock, CA.
- Turkey Live Haul located at 550 C. Street, Turlock, CA
- And Turkey feed mill, located at 3600 W. Main Street, Turlock, CA.


